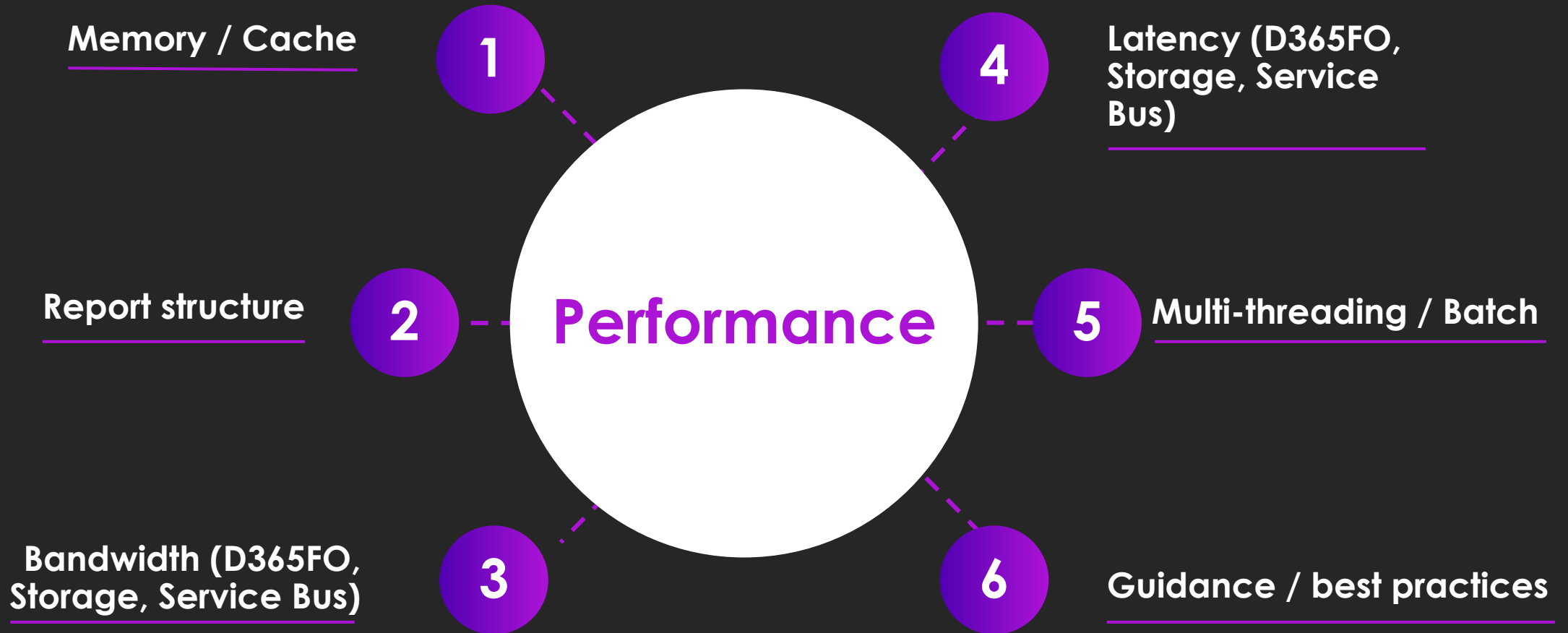

- LAC365FO 6.16 are compliant with PU46/10.0.22



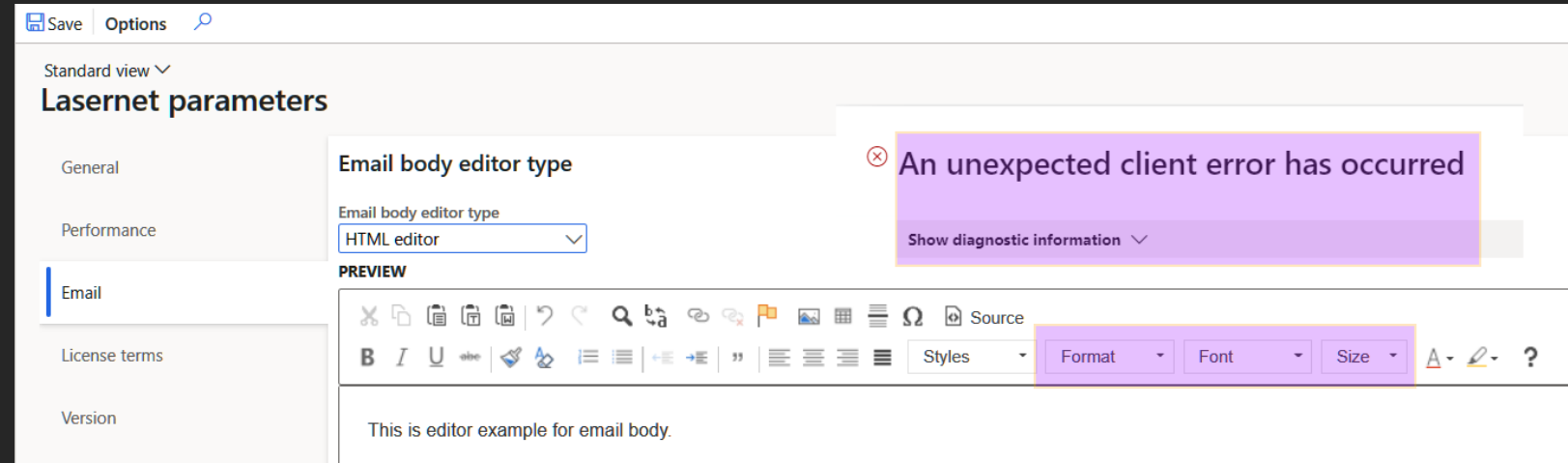


Performance guidance.

- Ensure Queues, Storage and hosted dynamics are located in same region
- Avoid “yellow elements” – Manually added elements
- Avoid sub-reports → Will introduce new feature in 6.17
- Add as much as possible through the Query Wizard
- Please let know if there’s any requirements which can’t get added by using the Query Wizard
- Avoid overhead of information
- Use the tools for benchmarking to identify best performance
- Always run multiple times to ensure everything is “cached”
- Verify performance over time – Including load of memory and CPU
- Ensure/compare performance after an upgrade (LAC or D365FO)
- Automize as much as possible

PROBLEM

When using the "New HTML editor control" and you try to open the lookup for "Styles", "Format", "Font", or "Size," you will get an error dialog saying: "An unexpected client error has occurred". Once this happened, clicking the Save button of the dialog won't do anything again.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Combo box selections in the toolbar would cause a client error due to having an incorrect context. The correct context is now being passed.
