This article provides a solution for the following error message which may appear in AX 2012 after the import of the Cumulative XP:

Error

Assembly containing type Lasetnet.license is not referenced.

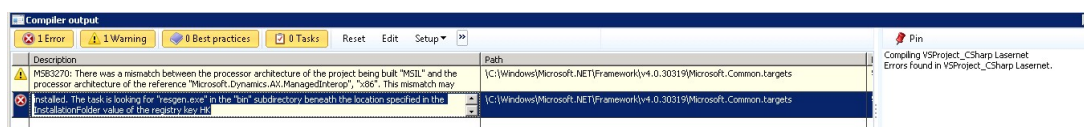
It appears when trying to print to Lasetnet or when you try to open a Lasetnet menu.

Resolution

Try to compile the Lasetnet C-Sharp project. You may see this compilation error:

SDK is not installed. The task is looking for "resgen.exe" in the "bin" subdirectory beneath the location specified in the InstallationFolder value of the registry key HK	\\C:\Windows\Microsoft.NET\Framework\v4.0.30319\Microsoft.Common.targets	2318	2	Err178
MSB3270: There was a mismatch between the processor architecture of the project being built "MSIL" and the processor architecture of the reference	\\C:\Windows\Microsoft.NET\Framework\v4.0.30319\Microsoft.Common.targets	1605	1	Err178

Or this:



Microsoft Windows SDK is not installed on the AOS server where you try to compile or the ResGen.exe file is located in a different folder than Axapta expected.

Install Microsoft Visual Studio or Microsoft Windows SDK for Windows Server 2008 and ".NET Framework 3.5" on the AOS. Then try to compile the Lasetnet C-Sharp project.

A similar error message could be Assembly containing type Lasetnet.ReportEngine.
