

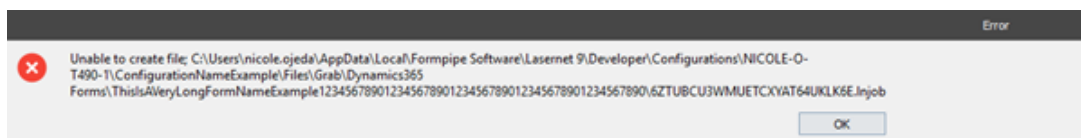
Error message: 'Unable to create file.'

Lاسernet

This article provides a solution for the following error that may appear in Lاسernet Developer:

'Unable to create file; [FilePath]'



This error occurs when the Lاسernet Developer is trying to access a file path that is too long. The maximum length for a file path in Windows is 260 characters.

In order to resolve this, minimize the number of characters in the file path by renaming folders as needed. Some examples include a shorter configuration name, form name and grab file name to limit the number of characters.

A cached copy of the configuration is stored locally on the computer in:

```
C:\Users\[Username]\AppData\Local\Formpipe Software\Lاسernet  
9\Developer\Configurations\[ComputerName]\[ConfigurationName]\Files\Grab\[ModuleName]  
\[FormName]\[GrabFileName]
```

Additional Information

Some examples of when the error can be triggered are when downloading a Grab file or when trying to open a configuration.
