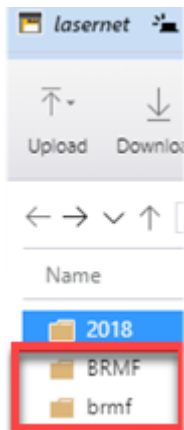


## Why are there Two Folders per Company in Lowercase and Capital Letters in Azure Storage Explorer?

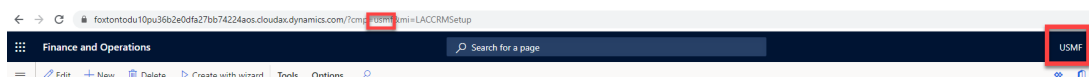

# Lasename for Dynamics 365

On occasion, the CompanyId folders for the same legal identity are in capital letters and sometimes they are not. An example can be seen in the following image:

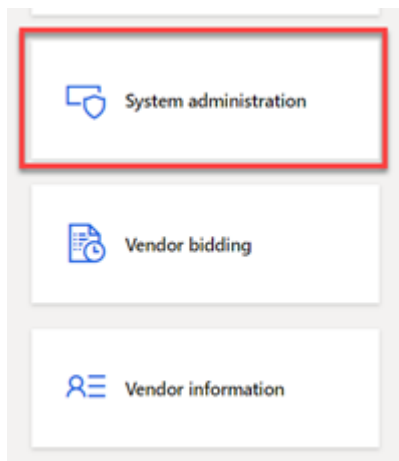


In Azure Storage Explorer, there are two separate folders for a report along with issues reported in the form criteria. When, for example, your default company is named USMF, other references to USMF are not in capital letters.

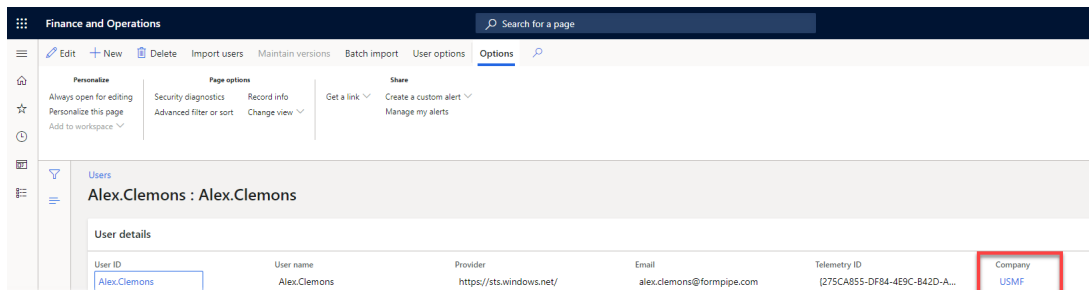


To set the default company, follow these steps:

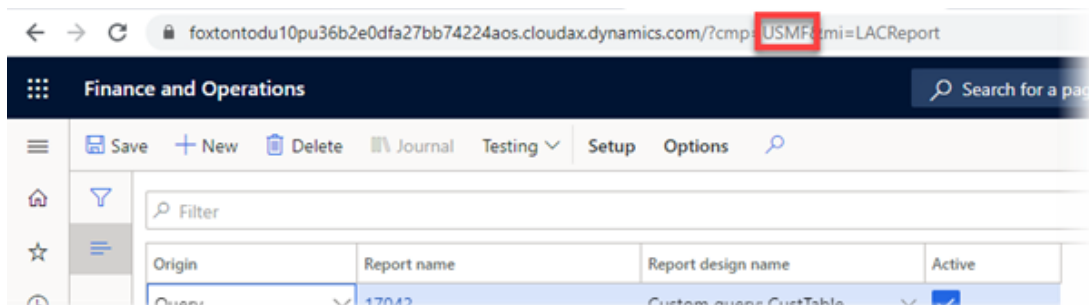
1. Open **Systems administrator**.



2. Click **Manage Users** and select your username from the User ID list.
3. Click the **Company** field dropdown menu and set the default company name.



The CompanyId is now in capital letters and the reports which are archived are in the folder USMF instead of usmf.
