Lasernet for Dynamics 365

In Lasernet FO Connector, **CompanyId** folders for a legal entity are sometimes capitalized, while some other times they are not.

For example:




Another example of this is the default company **USMF**. Its name is capitalized, but references to this company are not:




This is due to the default company not being set on the user account.

To set the default company, follow these steps:


1. Open Systems administrator.



- 2. Click **Manage Users** and select your username from the User ID list.
- 3. Click the **Company** field dropdown menu and set the default company name.



The **CompanyId** is now in capital letters, and the archived reports are in the folder **USMF** instead of **usmf**.
