PrintNightmare Update Issue - Windows Update on Server and Client Out of Date

Following on from the <u>PrintNightmare</u> issue identified with Windows recently, Microsoft have released a new update to fix some outstanding vulnerabilities. While this update fixes the issue, it can cause another issue with remote printing between a Client and Server machine on different patches. This has mainly been seen with printing via UNC paths but seems to also be a problem with printers shared via a print server.

So far we have received reports involving:

- KB5005613
- KB5005627
- KB5005030

Potential fixes

Potential fixes are to update all client and server machines to the latest KB number or remove the affected updates from the server or client.
